

# RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

Minutes of Lawrence Township Trustees

Regular Meeting

July 25, 2024

The Trustees of Lawrence Township met in regular session at 7:00PM. in the Charles E. Lundenberger Memorial Meeting Room. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ritterbeck. All Trustee were present.

Minutes from the July 11, 2024 regular meeting were approved.

The above bills were approved by the Board and checks were written.

## PUBLIC SPEAKS

Bolivar Fire Chief Lynch advised Trustees that he did a pre-inspection of Crazy Habanera and there will be a delay in opening due to a hood system.

## MEETING

Chairman Ritterbeck extended condolences on behalf of the Township in the passing of Bolivar Mayor Robert Lloyd's mother. Road Superintendent Myers presented Trustees with a quote from T. Rowley for tree removal on St. Pete and French Hill for \$5000, indicating that the trees to be removed are in power lines and unsafe for the township to remove themselves. Ritterbeck made a **motion**, seconded by Haueter to approve T. Rowley to remove trees. Ritterbeck:yes; Hauter:yes; Ackerman:yes. **Motion** passed. Myers received a quote from Action Now to spray three parking lots: basketball courts on Glenpark, River Community Park parking lot on Glenpark and lot located on Wilkshire Blvd for \$600. Ritterbeck made a **motion**, seconded by Ackerman to approve spraying of parking lots by Action Now. Ritterbeck:yes; Hauter:yes; Ackerman:yes. **Motion** passed. Myers received an updated quote for garage doors from Parkhill Door and Ritterbeck made a **motion**, seconded by Haueter to have garage doors replaced by Parkhill Door for \$60,331. Ritterbeck:yes; Hauter:yes; Ackerman:yes. **Motion** passed. Myers brought to the Trustees attention that when Gibler Rd. is paved semi-trucks using the road to turn around and will break up the new asphalt. Reflectors were discussed to prevent a semi from using the road, Trustees will reach out to the business owner to see what can be done to prevent this from happening. Myers checked roads and road signs. Zoning Inspector Weekley advised to be sure to check with the Army Corp. of Engineer along with the Township Zoning when purchasing property in Lawrence Township. Weekley spoke with Dollar General regarding the utility pole and it was determined that it was not installed on their property. Weekley will reach out to the owner of the property. AEP owns the pole and working to be sure utilities are underground as deed restrictions show. Weekley also suggested Trustees work on a Resolution regarding underground utilities. Trustee Ackerman received call concerning fires on French Hill where mulch has been collected. Bolivar Fire Chief Lynch is aware of the situation and it is an O.D.N.R. issue. Martina Mann advised Trustees that the Quarterly JSWMD grant has been submitted. A motion to adjourn was made and so ordered by Chairman.
