Minutes of Lawrence Township Trustees

Regular Meeting

October 31, 2024

The Trustees of Lawrence Township met in regular session at 7:00PM. in the Charles E. Lundenberger Memorial Meeting Room. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ritterbeck. All Trustee were present.

Captain Travis Stocker introduced Tuscarawas County Sheriff Adam Shaw who is the newly appointed sheriff for Lawrence Township.

Road Superintendent Myers advised Trustees that the garage doors have been installed and look good, the new truck was delivered by Ace with all the equipment installed, the old truck is ready to be sold, seasonal employees are done for the year, ditching and tree work being done and road and road signs have been checked. Zoning Inspector Ron Weekley advised that a Board of Zoning Appeals hearing has been requested by the new owners of the old car wash site, he has a new contact to help work on the map issues, working on the definition of Wilkshire Hills, still working on the utility pole installed by Dollar General and thanked the Trustees for the use of the Township building for collection of donations for North Carolina. Trustees thanked Weekley for organizing and delivering the donations. Trustee Ackerman reminded residents to vote on Tuesday, November 5. Fiscal Officer Ackerman provided Trustees with copy of letter from Tuscarawas County Auditor regarding a public hearing on Monday, November 4, 2024 on alternative method of formula for distribution of local government funds, all are invited to attend.
