Minutes of Lawrence Township Trustees

Regular Meeting

November 26, 2024

The Trustees of Lawrence Township met in regular session at 7:00PM. in the Charles E. Lundenberger Memorial Meeting Room. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ritterbeck. All Trustee were present.

Minutes from the November 14, 2024 regular meeting were approved.

The above bills were approved by the Board and checks were written.

MEETING

Road Superintendent Myers advised Trustees that crack seal began and will finish this week pending weather, working on pot holes, ditching on Blacksnake, new truck is working well, winter maintenance on equipment and road and road signs have been checked. Zoning Inspector Weekley reminded Trustees of Board of Zoning Appeals hearing December 2, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. for car wash for a setback variance, provided Trustees with a rough draft of letter to AEP which was approved to send out and will send out letter to Durbin regarding detention basin by certified mail. Ackerman made a **motion**, seconded by Ritterbeck to renew Bill Woodward as an alternate to the Board of Zoning Appeals for a three-year term. Ackerman: yes; Haueter:yes; Ritterbeck:yes. **Motion** passed. Ackerman advised Trustees of Regional Planning meeting December 3, 2024 at 9:00 a.m. regarding an allotment development in the Township. He asked Myers and Weekley to get a plan together on what the Township will require for this allotment to be developed i.e. separate construction entrance, detention basin wider roads etc. Ackerman will attend this meeting. Ritterbeck made a **motion**, seconded by Haueter to approve **Resolution 17-24 To Amend Appropriations to Align with Revenue**. Ackerman: yes; Haueter:yes; Ritterbeck:yes. **Motion** passed. Haueter made a **motion**, seconded by Ritterbeck to hire Stephen Hughes as a full time Highway Maintenance Worker starting December 16, 2024 with a starting wage of \$22 per hour with full benefits. Ritterbeck thanked seasonal workers Wayne Rex and Tom Lundenberger for their dedication and work for the township the last several season as they have requested not to return. A motion to adjourn was made and so ordered by Chairman.
